Lincoln County Democrats General Meeting

The meeting was called to order at 6:00pm by Chair Cherie Harbour.

Updates, congratulations & acknowledgements

Chair Harbour congratulated candidates and everyone who helped in the successful election campaign. She thanked PCP's all of those involved in getting out the vote, including Lisa Spence who led the coordinated campaign, and Eliot Sekuler who arranged publicity. She also thanked Kate Kelly for coordinating election observers and voter safety efforts.

Dave Haun provided analysis of the election, noting that 48% of the county-wide totals come from the unincorporated areas of the county.

LCDCC Committees activation, roles & structure in new year

Chair Harbour described plans for building out the Lincoln County Democrats as an organization by activating standing committees set out in the bylaws and by establishing new committees. If at the January 25, 2023, reorganization meeting she is elected Chair, her plan is to commence with this new structure. Attendees were invited to sign up for these future committees. Chair Harbour described the goal of having regional committees---north, south, and inland---to replace the satellite club model.

Re-organization meeting & officer elections Jan 25
